


How to connect to eduroam in Win7

1. Make sure that "eduroam" is within the signal coverage





2. Open "Network and Sharing Center", then choose "Set up a new connection or network"







3. Choose "Manually connect to a wireless network", change network name to "eduroam" and security type to "WPA2-Enterprise"






4. Choose "Change connection settings", then operate as the following steps










2. Enter “Manage wireless networks”, select “eduroam” and remove it
