Resources in the library are mainly in English, the ratio of foreign language and Chinese literature is 7 to 3.





Introduction

INTL ID is International Campus' unified user credential, uniquely identifying you to International Campus' IT applications and services, was in charged by Library and Information Center. You will use INTL ID as your username when you login in many computing resources and it forms the basis of your International Campus email address(*@intl.zju.edu.cn).

Mission - Ease your account management

The mission of INTL ID is to make itself as the ONLY account you need at International Campus rather than to memorize a variety of accounts and to create passwords for different applications. That's why we create INTL ID at International Campus. Due to this feature, INTL ID will play a vital role in your information security management.

Link the world with INTL ID

INTL Campus - By the end of this semester, people in INTL Campius could use INTL ID to connect wireless network and login to a series of applications on campus.

Main Campus - INTL ID also grants you access to applications from Zhejjiang University Main Campus like BlackBoard.

Clobal Range - You can login to UIUC's applications with INTL ID such as SVN. INTL ID also allows you to use global IT service like eduroam, with which you could connect the remote Wi-Fi offered by more than 6,000 Universities and institutes in 80 countries around the world.

International Teaching Environment



in International Campus

In order to offer the interactive teaching environment with inter-national standard, the tutorial classrooms account for 81.5% of the total 126 classrooms in international campus.

All tutorial classrooms are equipped with 86' all-in-one computers.

- Ten points touch control allows teacher to zoom in or out the content Also, it supports teacher to drag a file from one place to other.
- Wireless project allows users to project their laptop content without wired cables, it supports Windows as well as Mac. Also, it supports remote control which let staff to manipulate their content on the screen
- **SeeWo note** application as traditional blackboard, Allows tearchers to draw pictures or formula directly on the screen. The digital content can be saved as pdf file or JPG file later for sharing

Password: Your 1st line of Defense

The password helps you to protect your privacy and identity. The strength of your password is an important factor to consider. However, the password is effective only when you use one that is easy to remember but difficult to "break," and that is changed on a regular basis.

If passwords are guessed or stolen, someone can login in with your ID and password.

INTL ID password

Your INTL ID and password authenticate you before giving you access to various International Campus resources such as the Office 365, Blackboard, Peoplesoft and wireless network.

Updating your password

It is a good practice to change your INTL ID password on a regular basis, at least once a year. If you haven't changed your password yet, please go to the website: password.intl.zju.edu.cn to change your password and this can help you to create a stronger password.

Blackboard

Bb (http://c.zju.edu.cn) is our learning management platform for online interaction between teachers and students, it is also the #1 in LMS & E-Learning Platforms in the world. Inside of the platform, teachers can:

- Share their teaching material
- Release weekly assignment
- Conduct remote online communication
- Discuss the key content of course

It's also a great place for student to introduce themselves and to find their group members. Compared with wiki page created by teachers, or other learning management tools outside university, Bb inside ZJU has huge advantages in permission management, security, student, and staff support.

Dr. Simon Collyer: Keeping Pace with eLearning in Higher Education

Dr. Simon Collyer is the manager of eLearning system and support from The University of Queensland. On January 10th, 2018, Dr. Simon made a presentation in International Campus, ZJU. The main focus of his presentation was on eLearning system in The University of Queensland and what Intl Campus could do to catch up with foreign first-class university from the aspect of eLearning.



Dr. Simon pointed out that accelerating growth in technology is the key issue that causes increasing absorption gap for lectures. What IT people should do is to show academics benefits of using eLearning system and make it compulsory at the final stage.

Dr. Simon also gave some recommendations for ZJU such as building 'best practical' guidelines for advanced use of Blackboard across all courses. After the presentation, we shared with each other and learnt some practical experiences of using Blackboard in University of Queensland.

Virtual Desktop Interface in Academic Works

Virtual Desktop Infrastructure (VDI) is an alternative to traditional desktop computing which allows users to access a virtual session from any location without being tied to a single machine. The VDI service provides users with the virtual desktop environment and applications that best support their academic activities.

Your Virtual Classroom

Virtual Desktop Infrastructure (VDI) allows the administrators to have central management of software licenses granting in all virtual desktops. Due to this feature, VDI could help students easily get applications that are needed in their study rather than download and active applications in their own laptops or PCs.

A Significant Role in Examinations

Engineers could remotely and effortlessly build a professional test environment for exams since VDI enables centralized management of software installations and website access. However, in the exam, participants' virtual desktops in labs should only allow selective access to needed tools and websites. - A reasonable infrastructure to support both stability and extensibility, with multiple security policies and instruments in data backup and recovery.

—Xiashi Lantern Exhibition



Intl Mail Active User


There's quite a lot of applications within Office 365. However, Office 365 Forms allow you to accomplish things that other apps don't, such as quizzes, data recording, and workflows. Forms are a really useful tool when it comes to post questions, record results, and then output the collected data. Responses are easy to collect, and to be anaylized within the Office 365 Forms interface. It's also possible to see the responses time of each user completing these forms.

Intl Mail Active User

The active rate of office 365 increased from 47% to 92% between Jul. 2017 and Jan. 2018. This dramatic increasing trend happened to INTL mail (exchange mail) as well, which is the most heavily used section.

OneDrive Usage Count

Another popular section of office 365 is OneDrive. From the data analysis, the documents save in OneDrive in Jan. 2018 increased 10 times compared with the counterpart of Jul. 2017.

International


Original English textbooks are the first choice. It's likely to use the same textbooks with students in world-class universities.
