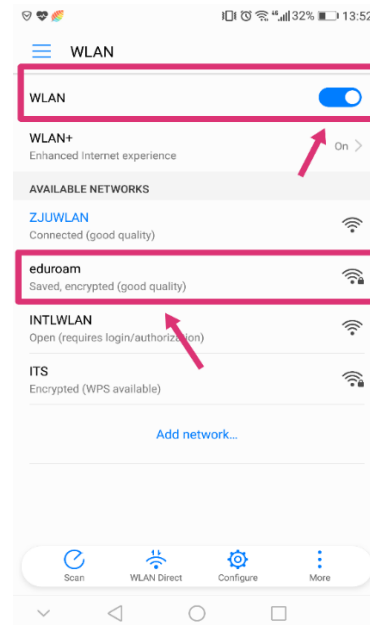
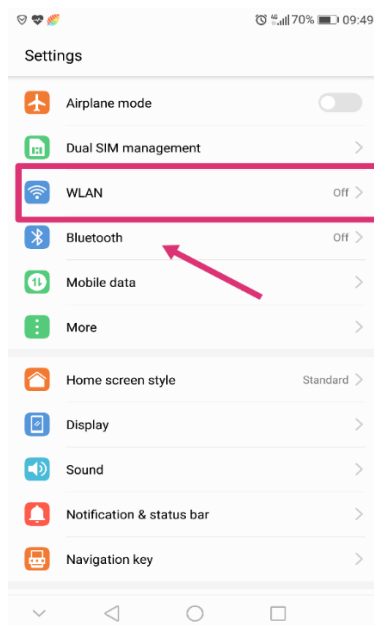


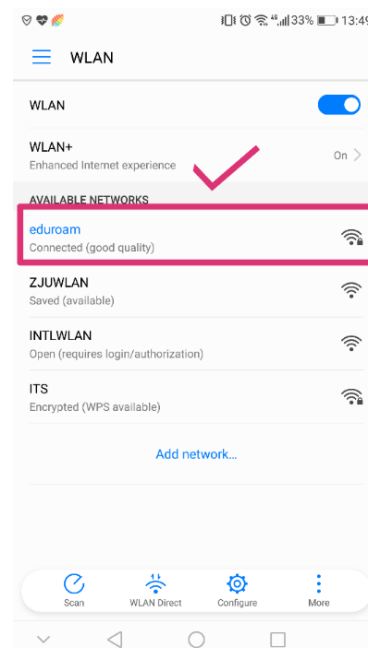
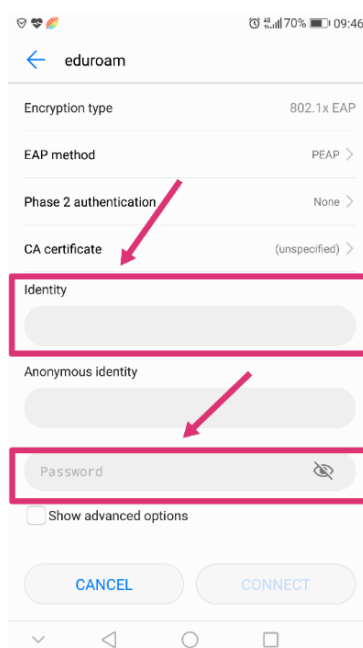
How to connect eduroam in Android

1. From the Android settings screen

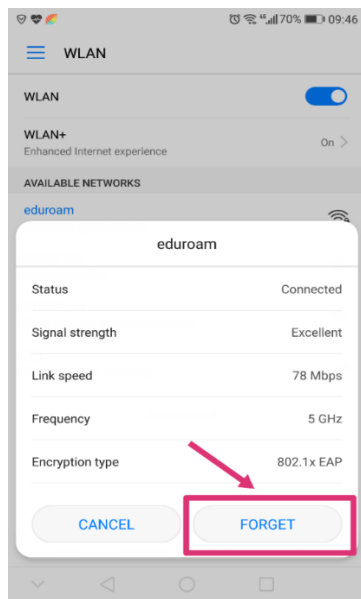
- Turn on WLAN
- Ensure the WIFI coverage and select 'eduroam'



2. Successfully Connect eduroam after inputting your INTL ID and password

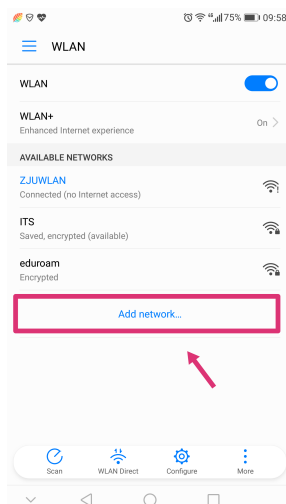


3. If you have connected 'eduroam' before but it doesn't work, you may have to forget it first. For example, if you change your password.

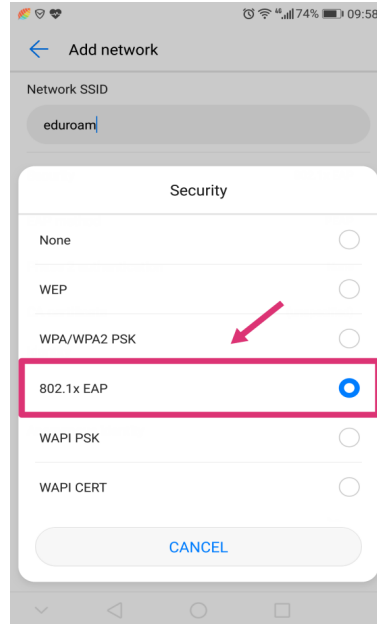
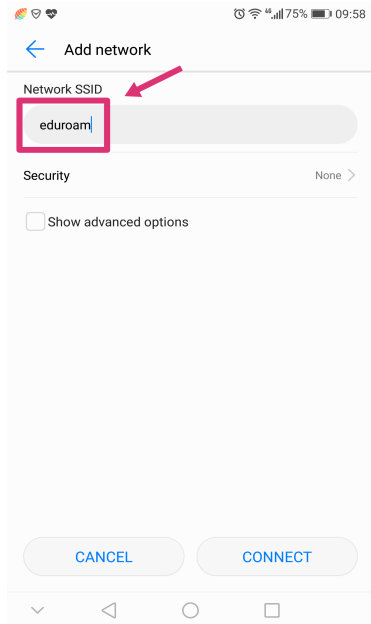


There are some situations we met that user could not connect the eduroam even they used correct account name and password, then you may need to set up a new network on your phone. Following the blowing steps to figure this out.

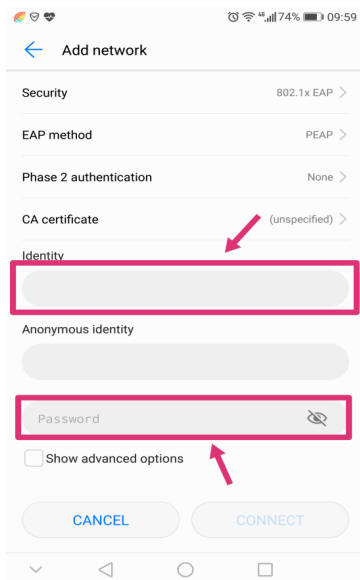
1. Select 'Add network'.
