

How to connect eduroam in Windows 7

1. From the Windows 7 Start screen or the Desktop
 - Locate the Wireless icon in the task bar (bottom right corner)
 - Click on the Wireless icon




2. A list of connections will be displayed
 - Ensure the WIFI coverage




3. Select 'Open Network and Sharing Center'




4. Select 'Set up a new connection or network' in 'Network and Sharing Center'




5. Select 'Manually connect to a wireless network'




6. Change the Network name to eduroam, change Security type to 'WPA2-Enterprise'




7. Select 'Change connection settings'




8. Select 'Security' and choose 'Settings'




9. Cancel the '√' of 'Verify the server's identity by validating the certificate'




10. Choose 'Advanced settings'



11. Click 'Specify authentication mode', choose 'User authentication' and 'Save credentials'



12. Successfully Connect eduroam after input your INTL ID and password in your 'credentials'



13. How to forget eduroam?

If credentials have been "saved" and your computer automatically logs in without prompting you to enter your INTL ID and Password you may have to "forget" your credentials before you can log in successfully. For example, if you change your password.

- Open 'Network and Sharing Center'



- Select 'Manage wireless networks', choose 'eduroam' and remove it.
